**COLOR-ONS®  
DIRECTIONS**

**PLEASE READ!**      **COLORING INSTRUCTIONS**      **IMPORTANT!**

1. Use your favorite crayons to color in the **IMAGE** side of the transfer sheet-**NOT** the side with the printed application directions.
2. Use **LIGHT** pressure when coloring to prevent damage to the special coating on the transfer. When applied the colors will be brighter.
3. For best results, begin coloring the design from the center and work outwards to the edge of the image.
4. Keep the coloring within the outside border of the design. Coloring outside of the image may transfer onto your garment.

**APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

1. This transfer is not recommended for nylon or garments that need to be dry cleaned! Pre-washing your garment is suggested.
  2. Preheat hand iron at setting between wool and cotton. If using a steam iron, remove all water from the iron.
  3. Must be applied to white or light colored garments.
- HAVE AN ADULT HELP YOU!**
4. This transfer must be ironed on a hard surface. A bath towel folded, on a firm table works much better than an ironing board.
  5. Lay out your garment and smooth out any wrinkles. Position the transfer on the garment, image side down.
  6. Iron the transfer by pressing down **FIRMLY** and steadily, constantly moving the iron **BACK AND FORTH** for 30 seconds, (longer time may cause discoloration of fabric). If transfer is larger than surface of iron, repeat this step several times until entire area has been covered.
  7. Let the garment cool off completely before removing the paper. If the transfer will not release from the paper or it is not soaked into the fabric, replace the special transfer paper and repeat steps 5 & 6.
  8. Save this paper until the garment has been washed several times. If the transfer was not properly applied, repeat steps 5 & 6.

DO NOT re-iron directly over the surface of an applied transfer. If your garment must be pressed or you want to apply more transfers to the same garment, cover any exposed imprints with this special paper.
